Pools Open May 24th

Memorial Day weekend is early this year which means the **Oak Tree Swimming Pools** will open **Saturday, May 24th**, if the weather permits.

Last fall Oak Tree had the pools scoped for cracks in the plumbing under the concrete. Five leaks were discovered and Sheehan Construction was hired to repair all leaks in the pool in April. The repair will make it much easier to control temperature and purity of the water.

The **Pool** will be **open daily** from **11:00 am** to **7:00 pm** if the weather permits. The pool hours may fluctuate in the first week of operation due to the lifeguards' school schedule.

Turf Talk by Tom Davies - CGCS

Currently there are three special projects taking place on the golf course:

1. The grass mounds being constructed between holes two and four near the landing will be seeded by mid May. These mounds will match those on hole eleven and fifteen and will give each hole an interesting look.
2. The new forward and championship tees will be in play by June 1st. The forward tees will allow our ladies, seniors and junior players to enjoy the course more. The new back tees on holes five, fourteen and eighteen will make the course even more challenging for the better players.
3. The rough area on the right side of the cart path on hole fifteen has been cleared of thick brush and dead trees. The old sheds have been removed giving the hole a wider rough. Seeding and grass germination should be completed by June 1st.

Oak Tree will continue to schedule verti-cutting and light top dressing every three weeks to give to you a smoother putting surface.
